BRAD RUNS FOR 'EL PRESIDENTE' part 2

THIS is the second instalment of this inaccurately named series. If you missed last month's article, it was divulged that I can only look to be a President aide, at best, due to a sordid past and some crimes against humanity.

I had a number of strong comments come through about last month's concept, making all car parks become electric vehicle re-charging points for electric vehicles. Joanne made some good points about what actually constitutes a carpark and asked if there should be minimum number of places before this rule kicks in. THE PENSION FUND IS RUNNING LOW

Unsurprisingly, with Spain's population getting older, the public purse has huge pressure to be able to supply an adequate payment for pensioners, so that they're not left with selling their homes or creating their own FanGirl pages. Please Granny, no! This is where I would like to emulate possibly the best pension scheme in the world, the Superannuation Guarantee that was introduced in Australia in 1991.

What's that you ask? It basically put into law that an employer has to pay an extra percentage of a salary to a superannuation fund, or what you are more likely to know as a private pension fund. Initially it was 3% and has grown incrementally until by 2027 when it will reach 12%. The



incremental increase is to make it easier for businesses to adapt. But the beauty of all this is that these funds are then invested! Over any 10 year period, most pension funds will average between 5-8% increase, even during downturns and crashes, and then compounded. It's a long-term investment, you see! You get



it when you retire, or your family get it when you die. That last bit was a bit of a downer, but considering 70% of the population don't have any life insurance, now they will!

WHERE TO INVEST

Australia's superannuation industry was worth more than \$1trillion back in 2009 and much more now. A simple rule that enforces 50% of investments to be maintained in Spain will bring a new wave of construction and infrastructure, businesses and employment. These are a lot of positives and I haven't even got to the best part yet!

FINALLY

In the short term, retirees won't have enough in their personal fund to support them, so will require a public pension as well, but this doesn't change anything really. It's in the medium to long term that the benefits will become clear, when people can retire and be self-sufficient, living off their own personal pensions. Hallelujah! The dual win of people having more money and the government are free to waste that money assigned for pensions in other ways!

A rough guide is if you had €500,000 in your pension fund when you retire, you could live off the investments without touching the base amount. A salary of €25,000 a year is really achievable, instead of the current €600-800 per month most retirees receive now.

There's obviously a lot more to it, but this is the basic premise. It works and it's been proven, so long as the government don't try to get their claws on that money too... OK, I see the flaw now. But besides that!

Brexit and UK Ex-Pats in Spain

Please note that current Covid 19 Restrictions may impact on this information:

RESIDENCIA

If you were legally resident in Spain before 1 January 2021, you will be able to stay. You must ensure you are correctly registered as a resident. Children must also be registered with their own residency document.

If you are registering for the first time, you will be issued with a biometric residence card called a Tarjeta de Identidad de Extranjero (TIE).

If you registered as a resident before 6 July 2020, you will have a green A4 certificate or credit card-sized piece of paper from Extranjeria or the police.

You can exchange your paper EU residence document for the new TIE but you are not required to. The Spanish government recommends obtaining the TIE because the biometric card is more durable. It will also simplify administrative processes and border crossings.

INCOME TAX

The UK has a double taxation agreement with Spain to make sure that you do not pay tax on the same income in both countries. If in doubt, contact us about double taxation relief.

Existing double taxation arrangements for UK nationals living in Spain have not changed.

As a Spanish resident, you must declare your global income to the Spanish authorities, no matter which country it came from. If you are not a resident, you will only pay tax on income that came from Spain.

We will be sending out our tax forms in March to complete the tax returns and payments by the end of June based on 2020 income.

DECLARATION OF OVERSEAS ASSETS

You may need to file an annual declaration of overseas assets called a Modelo 720. There are severe penalties if you do not file, or give incorrect or incomplete information.

This is a declaration only and does not incur taxes.

DRIVING LICENCES

If you are resident in Spain and have not exchanged your UK licence for a Spanish one, your UK licence will continue to be recognised until 30 June 2021.

If you were resident in Spain before 1 January 2021 and registered your details with the DGT (Spanish Traffic Authority) before 30 December 2020, you must make an appointment with the DGT to complete the exchange of your UK licence by 30 June 2021. You will have to show proof you are registered as a resident at the appointment.

You will have to give your UK licence to the Spanish Traffic Authority at your appointment. They will provide you with a temporary driving permit ('autorización temporal para conducir') to use until your Spanish licence is processed. This document is only valid in Spain and not in any other country.

The rules for exchanging a licence have not been confirmed for those that did not register their details with the DGT or moved to Spain after 1 January 2021. We will update this information when

more information is available.

You can use your Spanish licence in the UK for short visits, or exchange it for a UK licence without taking a test. We will update this information if there are any changes to the rules, as soon as it is available.

Lost, stolen or expired UK licences:

If you live in Spain, you will not be able to renew your driving licence in the UK. If your UK licence is lost, stolen or expired, you will need to apply to the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA) for a 'certificate of entitlement' to be able to apply for a Spanish driving licence.

MEDICAL

If you have a registered S1 form and were living in Spain before 1 January 2021, your rights to access healthcare will stay the same from if you are either:

- receiving a UK State Pension
- receiving some other 'exportable benefits'
- a frontier worker who lives in Spain and commutes to work in the UK

European Health Insurance Card (EHIC):

If you are not an S1 holder, but are registered for public healthcare in Spain in another way and are travelling outside of Spain, you must apply for a Tarjeta Sanitaria Europea (TSE - a Spanish-issued EHIC) online (in Spanish), or go to your nearest social security office (Insitituto Nacional de la Seguridad Social).

You must also buy comprehensive travel insurance to cover anything not covered by your TSE, EHIC or for travel to countries outside the EU.

If you were living in Spain before 1 January 2021, you may be eligible for a new UK-issued EHIC if you're:

- a UK student in Spain
- a UK State Pensioner with a registered S1
- a frontier worker with a registered S1

An EHIC is not a replacement for comprehensive travel insurance.

PASSPORTS & TRAVEL

You should carry your residence document (the green paper EU residence certificate or the new TIE), as well as your valid passport when you travel. If you have applied but not yet received your document, carry proof you have started the registration process.

If you have not yet applied for a residence document, you should carry evidence that demonstrates you are resident in Spain. This could include a tenancy agreement or a utility bill in your name, dating from 2020.

If you cannot show that you are resident in Spain, you may be asked additional questions at the border to enter the Schengen area, and your passport may

be stamped on entry and exit. This will not affect your rights in Spain.

Passports:

You must have at least 6 months left on an adult or child passport to travel to most countries in Europe (not including Ireland).

As a non-EEA national, different border checks will apply when travelling to other EU or Schengen area countries. You may have to use separate lanes from EU, EEA and Swiss citizens when queueing. You may also need to show a return or onward ticket.

You can travel to other countries for up to 90 days in any 180-day period without a visa for purposes such as tourism.

To stay longer than 90 days in any 180-day period, to work or study, or for business travel, you must meet the entry requirements set out by the country you are travelling to. This could mean applying for a visa or work permit.

Travel to the UK and Ireland has not changed.

BANK ACCOUNTS

The impact of the UK leaving the EU is that rules on whether banks can provide accounts to their customers who are resident in an EU/EEA country may change.

Different countries and different banks are taking different approaches.

These approaches will mean:

- some countries will not allow UK banks to continue providing accounts to residents
- some banks will be closing accounts for people who are EU residents
- some banks will continue to serve EU residents with existing accounts, but will not allow new accounts.

Your bank should contact you to let you know what they are planning to do. If you have any concerns about whether you might be affected, contact your Bank.

INVESTMENTS

Passporting rights have now ceased and the transition period has come to an end. Passporting refers to the regulation of financial services, allowing UK firms to continue to do business throughout the EU without the need for further authorisation.

Financial Advisory firms operating in Spain will no longer have UK FCA Regulation and must be regulated via a European Regulator.

It's difficult to predict the impact on any individual investments because this can depend on several factors.

It's possible there could be a short period of temporary market volatility, which might mean the value of your investments in the short term could rise or fall. Whether they fall or rise, and how much and how long, is difficult to predict.

If the value of your investments has fallen and you don't require access to these funds in the immediate future, this may not be a big problem because markets are likely to recover over time. However, if you're planning to cash in any investments in the immediate future, we recommend that you contact us for advice as soon as possible.

One of the reasons the Irish wear green, particularly on this day is, according to folklore, because green makes you invisible to the Leprechauns therefore, making you less prone to getting "pinched"! The perfect excuse to get out your green attire and join in the fun!

So here is our offering of an Irish menu to help keep you on your toes amidst the traditional pints of Guinness! Sláinte!



IRISH MALTED BREAD



INGREDIENTS:

270g strong brown bread flour
40g malted bread flour
4g dried yeast
55g malt extract
1tbsp olive oil



METHOD:

1. Place both brown bread flour and the malted bread flour into a bowl. Put the yeast in one side of the bowl and the salt in the other.
2. In another bowl put the malt extract with the olive oil, and 145ml warm water. Mix until the extract has melted.
3. Pour this into the flour mix and bring together to make a dough. Knead for 10 minutes on a floured board. Put the dough into a clean bowl, cover with a tea towel, and prove for 2 hours until it's doubled in size.
4. Shape the dough into a loaf and place in a lightly oiled tin.
5. Leave for another hour until it has doubled in size again.
6. Heat the oven to 220 C or Gas Mark 7. Bake the bread for 25 - 30 minutes. Turn out the loaf and leave to cool.

METHOD:

1. Fry the onion until soft then add the beef. Fry until browned then put into a large cooking pot.
 2. Fry the diced vegetables and add the Herbs. Add the Guinness and beef stock. Pour into the large pot.
 3. Cook in the oven at 220C or Gas Mark 7 for 2 hours until the Beef is tender.
- Serve with mashed potatoes.

IRISH CREAM TIRAMISU



INGREDIENTS:

4 eggs
100g golden caster sugar
500g mascarpone
100ml Irish cream liqueur
300ml strong coffee made with 2 tsp coffee & 300ml boiling water
175g sponge fingers
25g dark chocolate
2tsp coco powder



METHOD:

1. Separate the egg whites and yolks into 2 separate bowls. Whisk the egg whites until stiff.
2. Add the sugar to the yolks and whisk until thick and foamy.
3. Whisk the mascarpone and cream liqueur into the egg yolks until thoroughly mixed.
4. Fold in the whisked egg whites slowly.
5. Dip the sponge fingers into the coffee for a few seconds and place half of them into a dish or individual dishes. Spread half of the creamy egg, mascarpone and liqueur mix on top. Repeat, placing the rest of the sponge fingers, and another layer of creamy mix.
6. Grate the chocolate over the final layer of creamy mix. Dust over the coco powder. Serve.

GUINNESS STEW



INGREDIENTS:

1L or 2 cans Guinness
800g diced beef (needs to be rolled in a small amount of flour to thicken the gravy)
2 large carrots - diced
2 sticks of celery - diced
2 parsnips - diced
1L beef stock
A sprig of thyme and rosemary
2 onions - diced
1 punnet button mushrooms



Featured Artist ...

NINO MOJACAR

I recently had the privilege of meeting an amazing and unique person.

A lovely man called:

Bernardino Cortes alias 'NINO MOJACAR'

If you have been in Mojacar recently you may have seen this car along the playa.



This is the brainchild of 'Nino Mojacar', a sculptor and painter extraordinary. He constructed it during the Covid pandemic and parked it along the playa attracting much attention and fascination. The writing on the bonnet says

*"Juventud tesoro divino te vas para no volver
Cuando tengo ganas de llorar no lloro
Y a veces lloro sin querer."*

This translates to:

"Youth divine treasure, you leave never to return

*When I feel like crying I don't cry
And sometimes I cry without wanting to."*

Nino was born in Zamora, Spain, in 1941 and qualified as a mechanical engineer.



In 1965 he went to South Africa with the equivalent of £12 in his pocket and the intention to stay for two years. In the event, he worked all over Africa for twenty years, during the time of apartheid. He met his future wife, Elsie, in South Africa. She was English born but had moved to Africa when she was quite young.

They loved their life in Africa but in 1988 he returned to Spain with Elsie, initially to be around his family near Madrid. However, they soon left Madrid to move to Mojacar where he and Elsie had holidayed over the years.

They found a house that they could put their stamp on and Nino renovated it himself – welding, plumbing, tiling, etc. etc. He worked very hard to make this a unique house. In every corner there is something different and innovative. There is also

a small casita that is used for family and friends to stop over. Nino's artistic flair and his creative ability have produced mosaics and amazing designs in this special space. He also built a

tree house which has been visited by local school children.

At first he worked as a mechanic, fixing many cars in his area. However, he finally decided the time had come to follow his dream and started painting and sculpting.

In 2013 he started constructing a whale in his garden. Inside it he housed his various sculptures and paintings. Many of these represent adventures in his life.

For example, there is a shark from when he survived a shark attack whilst in South Africa. During his time in Africa, he spent a few years in Zambia and was appointed to oversee the provision of wood for a timber mill, where he was responsible for the welfare of all the 3,000 workers.



One evening, one of his men came to Nino for help. He had had his head split open with an axe. Nino pushed the split together and wrapped bandages round it, then took him to the local missionary post. Due to Nino's prompt action the man survived. In remembrance of this incident he has crafted a head in a tree with the scar clearly showing.

In 2020 he was ready to open the whale to the public, initially to the schools. However, the Covid outbreak has delayed that. When he is finally allowed to open to the public, don't miss it. Also tour the garden and see his many works. Most from recycled material. He lets nothing go to waste!

Nino has lots of stories of his adventures in Africa – and he has many photos that he loves to share with others. He is full of tales of his life which would fill a book. We might serialise it one day.

He is an amazing, fascinating and lovely man and it was indeed an honour to meet him.




THE CREW

Zoe Rylett & David Moxham have lived in Spain for over 20 years. They ran "Ferreteria El Real" and "The Full Swing Golf Shop" for many years. In January 2014 they closed these businesses and decided to leave Spain and moved to Bulgaria for a very special reason. with many people confined to their homes or shielding, Memoli's delivery service increased dramatically, requiring them to take on extra drivers. Just as both restaurant and kitchen space began to be an issue Gessika and Viorel were made aware of a beautiful restaurant just a few meters away from where Gessika's grandparents' restaurant had been. It was the perfect time to expand. Their new location at Las Marinas, Vera Playa is a beautiful setting and has two dining rooms as well as two open air terraces. However, in typical Memoli style they are already expanding the kitchen in the new premises to accommodate an extra pizza oven. If you haven't yet had a Memoli's pizza then you must try one soon. With the ability to cook 18 pizzas simultaneously your pizza will be ready to collect or delivered to your door in no time.


Sunshine and shadows



Welcome to your monthly hair dot com

EACH month I am looking forward to sharing my knowledge of hair care with you. As a Vocational Trainer and Assessor for the examiners SCOTVEC and a salon owner for over 30 years, my passion is the science of hair and how to respect it using salon chemicals.

Q) WHY AM I LOSING MY HAIR?

A) On average we lose about 50 to 100 hairs a day, it is a very normal part of the hair growth cycle. If you are tying your hair back more than usual, you are not giving the hair that has fallen through the day anywhere to go. So when you do eventually take it down and brush it out you will see a lot more hair coming out than usual. The same situation occurs if you are washing your hair less frequently; that hair has come away from the follicle but until you give it a good washing, it's just hanging around in your mane all waiting to make a break for the drain.

Q) HOW OFTEN SHOULD I HAVE MY HAIR CUT?

A) Hair grows – on average – 1cm every 4 weeks. Therefore within 6-8 weeks hair starts to split on the ends naturally between 6 and 8 weeks, so to keep your hair looking healthy having a light trim within this time would be best, if you have chemically treated hair, it may need trims sooner, rather than later. Hair grows at different rates all over the head which is why your hair starts to look uneven at the ends after a time. So, to have the hair trimmed ensures that the lengths look even, if this is the look that you like. If you want to grow your hair ensure you inform your hairdresser to trim the very ends which literally means the split ends.

Q) SHOULD I WASH MY HAIR BEFORE A COLOUR?

A) This all depends on the treatment that you are having. There is a myth that hair is better dirty when going to your salon, for me personally I prefer to work on clean hair. However, if you are having root colour, then chemicals will be going onto the scalp so, to leave your hair unwashed for 24 hours will help the natural sebum protect your skin from the chemicals. If you are washing your hair avoid scrubbing as this can lead to a sensitive scalp.



ON THE SCALP LIGHTENER

Prior to having this done I would not recommend washing your hair in the 48 hours prior to your appointment, as this is a very harsh process and your natural oil will be essential in protective your scalp from the inevitable burning sensation you will feel throughout this process.

LIGHTENER IN FOILS

If you are having blonde highlights done this means you are having lightener placed on the roots as close to the scalp as possible and contained in a foil. This means that no colour is going to be coming into contact with your scalp, so there is no reason to need a protective layer of natural oils, therefore you may wash your hair the morning of your hair appointment if you feel necessary. I would suggest that, if you do wash your hair, then give yourself a gentle shampoo and don't scrub the scalp excessively. This is just in case you do require a toner, but also as it will be getting a thorough wash after your highlights.

Also bear in mind that your stylist will be working on your hair for up to an hour without gloves on during the highlighting process, they will also have to get a good weave to achieve the best highlights. Therefore, please don't turn up with incredibly greasy hair for highlights, it's highly unpleasant and makes it harder to work with the hair.



Hi Elaine,

I'm so glad you contacted me because, this is a common problem for a lot of people. When we start a relationship, be it a friendship or romance, we often as you describe, try too hard and do too much. This can leave the other person in the relationship quite redundant. If you can imagine sitting opposite someone at a table and there is a line across the table half way between you and the other person. You are only responsible for your half of the relationship and they are responsible for their half. So if you are a kind and loving person you may offer them love, attention, kindness and time but only up to your 50% line. Then you should stop and wait to see what comes back. If nothing comes back, you shouldn't offer anymore, just leave it. If a little comes back, perhaps if they offer 20% back on their side, then you withdraw what you are offering back to 20% on your side and wait again.

Fail to notice water on floor because curtain was hanging out of bath the whole time.





Why I chose the Spanish life

Maxine Morgan






