

Sometimes you just want a taste of "home" and with autumn being my favourite season back in the UK, I thought I would share some lovely seasonal recipes that are on this month's specials back at my Sister's cafe Mama Feel-goods near Canterbury. Watch out for the caramel Apple cake on our Afternoon Teas at La Meseta this month!

#### CHICKEN AND LEEK GRATIN

#### Ingredients:

50g butter

500g boneless, skinless chicken thighs, cut in  $1 \slash 2$  in cubes

2 large leeks, trimmed and sliced

150ml cider

1 heaped tsp Dijon mustard

1 tsp soy sauce

<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub> tsp smoked paprika, sweet or hot, plus a little extra for sprinkling

300ml double cream

100g fresh breadcrumbs

50g cheddar, grated

Salt and freshly ground pepper

#### Method:

Preheat the oven to 200C/180C Fan/Gas 6. In a large casserole dish on a medium heat, melt half the butter and fry the chicken until golden-brown. Remove from the pan and transfer to a plate.

Add the leeks and the remaining butter to the pan and cook over a low heat until softened without colouring. Then add the cider, mustard, soy sauce, smoked paprika, cream, ½ teaspoon salt and a grind of pepper. Bring to a boil for 2–3 minutes or until thickened and well combined.

Add the chicken back to the pan along with any juices and stir together to heat through. Transfer to an ovenproof dish (approximately 26x20cm or a round 23cm diameter dish). Mix the breadcrumbs with the grated cheddar and sprinkle over the top

#### Bake for 20 minutes or until bubbling.



#### CARAMEL APPLE CAKE Ingredients:

For the cake

500g sharp green apples, peeled and chopped into 2cm pieces Zest and juice of 1 lemon 225g soft unsalted

225g soft unsatted butter 225g soft brown sugar 3 large eggs, lightly beaten 200g self-raising flour

2 tsp baking powder

50g ground almonds 1 tsp mixed spice Jar of apple sauce (for the filling)

Fudge pieces to decorate

#### CARAMEL BUTTERCREAM

#### Ingredients:

100g soft unsalted butter 200g icing sugar, sifted

2 tbsp caramel (from a tin or jar)

1 tbsp semi-skimmed milk

#### Method:

Preheat the oven to 180°C, fan 160°C, gas 4. Grease and line 2 x 20cm loose-bottomed round sandwich tins.

Toss the apple pieces in the lemon juice; put to one side. In a large bowl, beat the soft butter, sugar and lemon zest, then gradually add the eggs, mixing well between each addition. Fold in the flour, baking powder, almonds and mixed spice.

Drain the apple pieces and stir into the mixture. Divide equally between the tins. Bake for 25-30 minutes.

Remove the cakes from the oven and leave to cool in the tins for 10 minutes, then turn out onto a wire rack to cool completely.

To make the caramel buttercream, beat all the ingredients together until combined.

To assemble, spread the apple sauce on one of the sponge layers. Spread the other layer with the caramel buttercream and sandwich together. Spread the top of the cake with some more caramel sauce and decorate with fudge pieces. Then pop the kettle on and cut yourself a large slice!

## Welcome to your monthly hair dot com

Each month I am looking forward to sharing my knowledge of hair care with you. As a Vocational Trainer and Assessor for the examiners SCOTVEC and a salon owner for over 30 years, my passion is the science of hair and how to respect it using salon chemicals.

I will be giving you some useful tips and advice on how you can protect and care for your hair and how to make the most of your crowning glory.

#### Q) WHY IS MY HAIR SO GREASY JUST ONE DAY AFTER WASHING IT?

A) Our skin is covered in tiny pores, also called hair follicles. The hair follicles surround the root and strand of the hair within. Most of these hair follicles also contain the sebaceous glands, the glands that produce oil. This oil keeps the skin and hair healthy, moisturised and waterproof. It also helps prevent skin infections. These sebaceous glands are all over our body apart from the palms of the hands and the soles of the feet.

Some people genetically produce more sebum than others. As we age we produce less sebum. However, certain factors can encourage our glands to produce more sebum than is necessary by over stimulation. Oil near the roots can build up to a visible level in less than a 24-hour time span.

This build up can also cause an itchy scalp.

In my experience, people with fine hair notice the oil more quickly than people with thicker hair, this is probably because people with fine hair don't have as much hair to soak up that oil.

#### Some factors that can cause oily hair:-

Hormones
Stress

- 3) Poor diet
- 4) Medication
- 5) Product build up
- 6) Over washing your hair
- 7) Not rinsing the hair properly
- 8) Washing your hair with hot water that is too hot
- 9) Excessive scalp massaging whilst washing your hair
- 10) Rapid change in body tempriture
- 11) Humidity
- 12) Overuse of hair products

To combat the grease you firstly need to find out what is causing your sebaceous glands to overproduce sebum.

#### Some tips on combating greasy hair

 When washing your hair make sure the water is not too hot
Do not massage too vigorously, a light massage should be sufficient

3) Use a dry shampoo if possible, this will soak up the grease4) If you do not like using dry shampoos use a shampoo for greasy hair

- 5) Wash your hair once a week, twice at most
- 6) Ensure that you rinse your hair thoroughly after washing
- 7) Only condition the mid lengths and ends of your hair

8) Brush your hair to encourage the sebum to work towards the ends of the hair, sebum is one of the best natural conditioners.

I hope this has helped and I look forward to many more of your questions.


