There is a moment, usually sometime in early December, when the collective pressure of Christmas lunch starts to creep into the air. Supermarkets roll out their mountains of sprouts, glossy magazines begin promising "the ultimate perfect feast", and suddenly it can feel as though we're all meant to be auditioning for a festive cooking show, judged by an unseen panel of stern experts.

Well, here's the calm and liberating truth: Christmas lunch is really just a Sunday roast wearing a novelty jumper.

Yes, there might be one or two extra trimmings and perhaps a

slightly fancier table runner, but at its core, it's the same comforting meal many of us have prepared dozens of times before. And if your family prefers peas to sprouts? Serve peas. If someone hates cranberry sauce? Leave it out. If the pudding comes from the supermarket instead of a handwritten family recipe passed down through five generations—no one needs to know and even less, no one needs to mind.

The heart of Christmas lunch isn't culinary perfection. It's the feeling of being together.

Let the Menu Fit Your People

Tradition is lovely, but only when it brings joy. If your family adores roast chicken more than turkey, roast chicken it is. If someone requests Yorkshire puddings at Christmas—why not? This meal should reflect the people at the table, not the picture on the front of a magazine.

Consider creating a menu with two questions in mind:

- 1. What does everyone actually like to eat?
- 2. What can I prepare without feeling flustered, weepy, or in need of a deep lie down in a darkened room?

This simple approach encourages the most crucial ingredient of

the day: ease.

Prepare in Advance (But Only if It Helps)

Preparation can be wonderfully soothing when it reduces stress, not when it becomes a marathon. Potatoes can be peeled and parboiled the day before. Vegetables can be chopped and stored in airtight containers. Stuffing can be mixed and refrigerated, ready to pop into the oven.

However, if prepping ahead starts to feel like a second full-time job, pause. The goal is less work, not more. There is no prize for the person who wakes up on Christmas Eve to pre-chop their

Cheat Happily and Without Apology

Let us be very clear: storebought shortcuts are a gift from the culinary heavens. Pre-made gravy? Use it. Presliced vegetables? Excellent. A dessert bought from your favourite bakery? Delightful. We sometimes imagine that everything must be homemade for it to 'count', but what really counts is the laughter around

the table, not whether the brandy butter was whipped by hand or purchased from aisle six.

Your time and energy are part of the meal too. Spend them wisely.

Simplify the Table

You don't need a tablescape worthy of a lifestyle photoshoot. A clean cloth, a candle or two, and a sprig of greenery from the garden can look warm and lovely. Children's drawings used as place mats? Charming. Mismatched Christmas napkins from years past? Full of stories.

Perfection is not the goal. Comfort is.

Share the Load

The idea that one person must be maestro of the entire meal is outdated. Delegate with grace. Someone can pour drinks, someone else can shepherd dishes to the table, and another can be in charge of the all-important "is everyone sitting comfortably?" check.

People like to help. It also gives the meal a sense of togetherness that feels festive in the best possible way. It's the Togetherness That Matters At the end of the day, no one will remember whether the gravy was a

touch thick or the roast potatoes less than golden. But they will remember the warmth of conversation, the familiar teasing, the shared stories, and the comfort of simply being together in a season that, at its heart, is about gratitude.

So let Christmas lunch be exactly what it is: a roast dinner with people you love. Everything else is just decoration.

STRANGE SPORTING FACTS....

CONTINUED FROM NOVEMBER ISSUE...

61) West Indian fast bowler Courtney Walsh holds the record for obtaining most ducks in Test match cricket – 43 in a total of 132 games.

62) South African spinner Hugh Tayfield holds the record for the most consecutive balls bowled without conceding a run, with a total of 137 in a Test match against England in 1956-57. This feat translates to 22.5 six-ball maiden overs.

63) Two Israeli teams set world record with a total of 56 penalty kicks in an end-of-season shoot-out on 21 st May 2004. SC Dimona and Shimshon Tel Aviv initially played out a 2-2 draw after 120 minutes in a semi-final promotion play-off in Israeli's third tier before the game was decided by a penalty shoot-out which Dimona eventually won 23-22. In fact, eleven spot-kicks were missed in the shoot-out.

64) The tallest sportsman to compete at senior level is Canadian wrestler Eduard Beaupre who stood 2.52m/8ft 3ins tall in bare feet. Known as 'the Willow Bunch Giant' he won every 'fight' he contested and it was a huge surprise when he died in 1904 at the age of 23.

65) Confirmed in the Guinness Book of Records, the longest drive ever made in competitive golf is 515 yards (471 metres) by American Mike Austin in the US National Open Qualifier in 1974. He used a steel shafted persimmon wood driver. And for the record, the longest-drive of all-time, at non-competitive level, is 579.6 yards, made by another American, Kyle Berkshire, at the Rochelle Ranch course in Wyoming in 2023.

66) GB driver Lewis Hamilton holds the world record for most F1 Grand Prix race victories with 105 to date. Second in line is the German Michael Schumacher with 91 race victories.

67) In December 1979, in a Test Match between Australia and England in Perth, one of the most famous entries in a cricket score-book was made. It read: Lillie caught Willey bowled Dilley.

68) Over a period of 145 years – 1880 to 2025 inclusive – West Bromwich Albion FC had no less than 51 players with the Surname name Smith on their books (at all levels).

69) The Oakmont country club is the home of the world's toughest golf course. Situated near Pittsburg in Pensylvania, it was initially opened in 1903 and has almost 200 bunkers to avoid!

70) Muthiah Muralitharan holds the record for taking the most wickets at Test Match level. The Sri Lanka spin bowler took a grand total of 800 during his career which spanned 18 years: 1992-2010.

71) Only one footballer (to date) has gained over 200 senior international caps. He is Portugal's forward, Cristiano Ronaldo who in 2025, had more than 220 to his name, having gained his first in 2003.

72) Only one player so far – goalkeeper Peter Shilton – has made over 1,000 Football League appearances, and he also collected a record 125 full England caps (his first in 1970, his last in 1996). Shilton played his club football for Leicester City, Stoke City, Southampton, Nottingham Forest, Leyton Orient, Plymouth Argyle, Wimbledon, Coventry City, Derby County, West Ham United and overall he played in 1,390 first-class matches for clubs and country.

73) All 22 players who took part in a 2001 Bradford Sunday League game involving Amarmilan CC versus Yorkshire LPS, had the same surname of Singh.Amarmilan who won the match by 31 runs (106 against 75).

74) The Wanderers – not Bolton or Wolves – won five of the first seven FA Cup finals played between 1872 and 1878.

75) The 'Ginger' McCain-trained Red Rum won the Grand National steeplechase three times in four years: 1973, '74, and



'77. He did not run in the 1972 National, but he did compete in the 1975 race when L'Escargot denied him a hat-trick of victories.

76) Irishman Tony McCoy was champion National Hunt jockey 20 years in succession – 1995-96 to 2014-15 inclusive. He rode a record 289 winners in 2001-02, 258 in 2002-03 and 253 in 1997-98.


77) The first-ever 70,000 plus crowd to attend a Premiership football match was in April 2006 when Manchester United played Arsenal.

78) Cyrille Regis scored in his first reserve (2 nd XI) game, his first friendly, his initial League Cup-tie and in his first FA Cup match for WBA in the late 1970s.

79) In season 1930-31 West Bromwich Albion became the first team to win the FA Cup (beating neighbours Birmingham in the final) and gain promotion from the Second Division.

80) The first set of twins ever to play together in a Premiership match were Adam and James Chambers, who appeared for WBA against Arsenal at Highbury in December 2002.

OOK REVIEW

GROWN Tiffany D. Jackson

Tiffany D. Jackson has once again proven herself to be one of the most vital voices in contemporary literature with Grown, a powerful, unsettling and deeply affecting novel that lingers long after the final page. Inspired in part by real-world conversations around celebrity power, accountability and the exploitation of young girls, this book feels not only timely but necessary.

Grown follows Enchanted Jones, a gifted young singer whose dreams of stardom are swiftly entangled with the dangerous attentions of a famous R&B artist. Jackson does not sensationalise the subject matter. Instead, she writes with clarity, empathy and a sharp understanding of the ways in which society excuses predatory behavior,

particularly when the victim is young, Black and female. The narrative moves with both urgency and compassion, illuminating how manipulation can masquerade as mentorship, affection or opportunity.

What makes this novel especially relevant today is the ongoing cultural reckoning with abuses of power in the entertainment industry and beyond. Tiffany D. Jackson does



not simply echo public conversations; she deepens them. She challenges the reader to look past headlines and ask harder questions about who is believed, who is blamed and who is protected. Her portrayal of Enchanted's emotional world is so precise and heartfelt that the reader cannot help but feel the weight of her journey.

Tiffany D. Jackson's writing is exceptional: vivid, lyrical and impeccably paced. She gives Enchanted her full humanity, her dreams, doubts, joys and pain, thus inviting readers not just to witness her story but to truly see her. The result is a novel that is both a page-turner and a profound social commentary.

Grown is not an easy read, but it is an essential one. Tiffany D. Jackson's talent is undeniable, her storytelling fearless, and her commitment to truth unwavering. This book deserves to be widely read, discussed and remembered.
