Tandoori Chicken Tray Bake THE PERFECT HEARTY AUTUMN DISH

Nothing is more pleasing than a one tray delicious recipe and this dish will not disappoint. Perfect for those cooler Autumn

Prep time: 1hr 15m (plus marinating time (see method)

Cook time: 1hr - Serves: 4

Ingredients

Tandoori chicken

1/2 cup (140g) Greek style yoghurt, plus extra for serving

1/3 cup (100g) tandoori paste (or whatever Indian curry paste you have in the fridge)

6 chicken thighs, skin on and bone in

1 brown onion, finely chopped

1 clove garlic, minced

40g ghee (or use 1 tablespoon oil and 30g butter)

300g (1½ cups) long grain rice, rinsed and drained

3 cardamom pods, crushed and seeds removed (use a mortar and

1 teaspoon fine salt

1/4 teaspoon ground turmeric

625ml (2½ cups) chicken stock (or water), warmed

Coriander sprigs, to garnish

Method:

Stir the yoghurt and tandoori paste in a large bowl to combine. On each thigh, cut two 3cm incisions across the skin into the

flesh. Then, add the thighs to the tandoori mixture, pushing into the incisions to help get as much flavour as possible into the meat. Cover and place in the fridge for at least an hour (or overnight), to marinate.

Place the onion, garlic and ghee into a large 20cm x 30cm deep-sided baking dish and stir to combine. Spread out over the base. Place the dish into the oven, then crank the temperature to 200°C conventional (180°C fan-forced). Cook for 15 minutes, open the oven and give the onions a stir to ensure not sticking. Cook for 10 minutes, or until onions are softened. Remove the baking dish from the oven.

Tip the rice into the dish and spread out evenly. Sprinkle over the cardamom seeds and salt. Stir the turmeric into the hot stock (or water) to dissolve, and pour over the rice to give it a bit of colour. Arrange the marinated chicken pieces, skin-side up over the top. Cover the baking dish with a large piece of foil, sealing around the edges. Return the baking dish to the oven. Bake for 30 minutes. Remove from the oven and take off the foil, being careful of the escaping steam. Place back in the oven for a further 15 minutes uncovered, to allow the chicken to brown.

Transfer the hot baking dish to a cooling rack. The surface rice will have a light crust and be fluffy underneath and the chicken golden around edges. Leave to stand for 5 minutes before serving.

Serve scattered with fresh coriander sprigs and blobs of yoghurt.

Biryani-style rice: The rice in this dish has a rich, spiced depth, similar to a dirty rice or biryani — perfect for soaking up all the tandoori flavours.

Bold is best: Don't hold back on spices and herbs! The more flavour, the better.

Ghee alternatives: If you don't have ghee, swap it for any neutral oil or a mix of butter and oil.

Slow-sweated onions: Starting with onions in a cold oven helps them sweat and develop a deeper, sweeter flavour.

Fresh cardamom for the win: If possible, use freshly shelled and crushed cardamom for a more aromatic and vibrant flavour.

A Year in the Broom Closet: What I've Learned Pitching TV Formats

It's been almost a year since I decided to see if I could sell a TV show from a broom closet in southern Spain. Not literally a broom closet, but close enough - a small room, a laptop, and a Wi-Fi signal that drops out whenever the neighbour microwaves something.

I started with a few ideas, a vague sense of how the industry works, and a deeply misplaced confidence that LinkedIn messages like "Hey, I've got something I think you'll love!" would lead to immediate success. Spoiler: they didn't.

But along the way I've learned a few things - about TV, persistence, and the fine art of refreshing your inbox while pretending to be a calm and balanced human.

1. The "Yeah, Send It To Me" Mirage

When a TV executive says "yeah, send it to me," what they really mean is "sure, I'll glance at it right after I retire."

The first few times, I thought I was in. I spent nights perfecting pitch decks, trimming videos, writing clever taglines like "Where greed meets morality!" Then - silence.

After a while, you realise the entertainment industry is basically an airport lounge: people are always "just about to go somewhere," but nobody actually boards your flight.

2. The Great LinkedIn Experiment

You can, in theory, pitch an international game show from your living room. In practice, it's mostly you sitting there trying to craft the perfect message that sounds confident but not delusional.

"Hi [Executive], I'm an English teacher in Spain who's created a show about psychological warfare. Interested?"

Sometimes they reply. Sometimes they ghost you. Sometimes they move to another company halfway through your conversation and you end up pitching a show to a stranger who's now managing Batman spin-offs.

3. Making Sizzle Reels on a Teacher's Salary

You quickly learn why production companies exist: because editing AI footage at midnight while your students' essays are still unmarked is a very specific kind of madness.

There's a point where you're watching yet another Al actor blink unnaturally while saying your dialogue, and you think, "Is this genius or a cry for help?"

But necessity breeds creativity. And honestly, making something - even a dodgy Al trailer - feels infinitely better than waiting for permission to start.

4. The Three-Format Strategy

At some point I realised having one show is like showing up to a job interview with one outfit - you'd better hope they like blue.

So now I've got three: a reality competition, a psychological game show, and something that might accidentally make people cry. The logic is simple: if one's "too niche," maybe the next is "perfect for our slate."



Of course, "our slate" is often a mystical concept executives use like horoscopes: "We love your idea, but it's not aligned with our current slate."

5. The Teaching Job vs. The Dream

By day, I teach teenagers who have zero interest in conditionals. By night, I send game show pitches to LA, London, and Madrid.

Sometimes I wonder if my students secretly think I'm unhinged: one minute I'm explaining "if + present, will + infinitive," the next I'm mumbling about psychological endurance challenges and moral dilemmas.

But weirdly, teaching keeps me sane. It's grounding. And occasionally, one of them will say something so absurdly creative I jot it down thinking, that could actually work in a show.

6. The Waiting Game

The waiting is the killer.

You get a nibble, then a pause, then a polite "let's reconnect in a few weeks," which in TV terms means "check back after the next Ice Age."

Right now, I've got one big meeting pending with a major distributor. It could be the turning point. Or another chapter in the ongoing saga titled "Brad Refreshes His Inbox."

Either way, I'm still here.

7. What I've Learned (So Far)

- Everyone in TV is friendly, busy, and mildly allergic to commitment.
- Royalty structures are either brilliant or incomprehensible sometimes both.
- "Distribution" sounds glamorous until you realise it mostly involves emails about rights territories.
- The best advice always comes from people who haven't sold anything either, but have great opinions.

Mostly, I've learned that the only real difference between "aspiring" and "working" is whether you stop trying.

So if you see a man in Mojácar looking slightly manic, muttering about "format rights" while carrying a stack of grammar worksheets - that's me.

I might be preparing to pitch a game show about human greed to a European distributor, or I might be trying to explain phrasal verbs to teenagers who've already stopped listening.

The sound of waves across the road, natural light streaming through the windows, and the gentle hum of focused work — this isn't your typical office. DeskSpace Coworking has opened on Mojácar Playa, and it's redefining what "going to work" looks like in our corner of Mojácar.

Tucked in the same block as Platino Gym opposite the beach (between Brico Lopez and Mandala), the space is bright, calm, and professional — a little oasis of productivity with sea views and a friendly vibe. I met with owner Angus to learn more about Mojácar's newest workspace.

Q: So Angus, what is a coworking space?

A: We're basically a large shared office with seating for around 15 people. Some have said we are like a TARDIS (looking at you Dr Who fans) – we're bigger on the inside. Think of it as a professional space where, if you need a desk, you can come for a day, a week, or longer. Everything's set up and ready for you --fast Wi-Fi, comfortable seating, good lighting, and of course, coffee (and tea) on tap.

For many people, it's the ideal setup: an office with superfast internet, without the commitment of rental contract.

Q: Who uses a coworking space?

A: So far, I would say there are three sorts of people.1. Local professionals.

We often hear people say it's "great to escape the same four walls," and that they enjoy the company of like-minded professionals. Even just seeing other people working can help with motivation — it's that subtle accountability you don't get when you're alone at home.

Others crave a change of scenery — or just some quiet time to focus without the distractions of home. Or they just don't have quiet space with kids, dogs, or the builders next door. We have a professional meeting space to have a meeting that is not in your lounge. We even had someone who needed to spread out all



their papers and "seriously concentrate" – talk about "serious admin".

2. Visitors to Mojácar.

When friends or family come to visit, there's often one person who still needs to work remotely. DeskSpace gives them a reliable, comfortable place to do that — with strong Wi-Fi and everything set up, so they don't have to take over the dining table (and then pack it away at mealtimes!).

We also have external monitors available, which can make a big difference for people who need a proper workstation.

It's popular with short-term visitors who want to enjoy the beach life but still keep on top of their work. So far, we've welcomed people from Barcelona and Madrid extending their holidays, an accountant from Sweden wanting to separate her "work" time from "holiday" time, and a technical account manager from South Africa who appreciates the reliable Wi-Fi, large monitors, and air-con.

Naturally, as most of our Facebook posts are in English, we've also had visitors from England, Wales, and Ireland (nope – no Scottish visitors yet).

I speak English, reasonable Spanish, and some rusty Polish — which helps make people feel welcome.

3. Digital nomads.

There's a growing community of professionals who can literally work from anywhere. Since Spain introduced the Digital Nomad Visa (DNV), we're seeing more people basing themselves in Mojácar for a few months

— escaping the cities, soaking up the sunshine, and finding a balance between work and lifestyle. DeskSpace gives them a sense of structure and community, with like minded people.

Q: It sounds flexible — how does it work in practice?

A: Yes, flexible - that's the idea. Some people just drop in for a day when they need to concentrate, while others take a desk more permanently, using us as their main office.

I try to keep things simple: all-inclusive pricing, no complicated contracts, and everything ready to go in the time it takes to make a cup of coffee — or tea, both free!

Packages start from €6 +IVA per day – all included. We have a small kitchenette, a meeting area and a newly renovated, wheelchair-accessible bathroom. There's plenty of parking, and desks with a glimpse of the sea.

Q: When are you open?

A: We're open Monday-Friday from 10:00-17:00, feel free to just call in during these hours - no appointment / pre-booking required. ALSO, we can be open longer hours by appointment - just send me a message (details below).

Q: What are the costs?

A: We have a range of options to suit different needs. I have tried to cover all eventualities without over complicating matters. Whether you want a pack of 10, all month or just a day. You can find more info on our website: https://deskspace.es/pricing/



Q: What's the vibe like when you walk in?

A: Warm and welcoming. Everyone's doing their own thing, but there's a nice energy that comes from being around motivated, creative people. We're not trying to be corporate — we're about connection, productivity, and community.

Mojácar has always attracted interesting people writers, designers, entrepreneurs, and travellers — and DeskSpace brings some of them together. Sometimes it's just a quick chat over coffee that sparks an idea or collaboration. That's the magic of coworking — it's work, but with a human side.

Q: You've mentioned community — are you doing any local events?

A: Yes! In October we hosted a Tech Meet-Up. We'll definitely be organising more events over the coming months — not just tech-related, but things like marketing workshops, networking mornings, or even informal "laptop and latte" meet-ups.

It's part of our goal to make DeskSpace more than just desks — we want it to be a hub for professionals, creatives, and entrepreneurs in Mojácar and the surrounding towns.

Q: Finally — why Mojácar?

A: Mojácar has this balance of calm and creativity. The weather's great, the sea's close, and it's an inspiring place to live and work.

Coworking spaces are common in cities, but smaller towns like Mojácar are starting to see the benefits — especially as more people embrace remote work. DeskSpace fits right into that shift.



STRANGE SPORTING FACTS....

CONTINUED FROM OCTOBER ISSUE...

41) An MV Augusta motor cyclist won 18 of the 19 Motor GP 500c class races between 1956 and 1974. The Italian Giocomo Agostini and GB's Mike Hailwood were the main riders.

42) The biggest win in senior one day cricket was achieved by England in 2003 when they defeated Sri Lanka by 317 runs

43) England registered the biggest-ever Test Match win in August 1938 – scoring 903-7 declared as they hammering Australia (201 and 123) by an innings and 579 runs at The Oval.

44) England (521 and 342-8 declared) also defeated Australia (122 and 66) by 675 runs in a Test Match in Brisbane in December 1928.

THE WELL By Catherine Chanter

Catherine Chanter's The Well is one of those rare novels that defies easy categorisation. It is part dystopian fable, part psychological drama, part spiritual allegory. It's not the sort of book I would usually reach for, and yet, once I started, I found myself strangely compelled to keep turning the pages. There's a magnetic quality to both the writing and the atmosphere — unsettling, lyrical, and quietly relentless — that made it impossible to walk away. The premise is immediately intriguing: in a near-future England gripped by drought, only one farm, "The Well", still has water. This miracle, or curse, depending on perspective, attracts attention, suspicion and eventually persecution. At the heart of the story is Ruth Ardingly, who retreats to The Well with her husband Mark in search of a simpler life. What unfolds is anything but simple. The CATHERINE CHANTER

rain that blesses their land isolates them from a parched and desperate nation, and what begins as a retreat into pastoral peace descends into claustrophobia, religious fanaticism, and moral ambiguity.

Catherine's writing is rich and evocative, with a sense of foreboding that seeps through every page. The landscape is vividly drawn, lush, dripping and alive and, a stark contrast to the dry, dying world beyond The Well's borders. The

book often reads like a dream sequence, shifting between memory and reality, hope and despair. At times, this lyrical style borders on overwrought, but it suits the feverish mood of the book.

What kept me hooked was Ruth herself. She's not a particularly likable narrator, but she's deeply human, flawed, yearning and sometimes self-deceptive. As her isolation grows, so does her instability and the writer explores that psychological unravelling with great skill. The novel raises uncomfortable questions about faith, guilt, and the limits of redemption. That said, I did have mixed feelings. The pacing falters in places. The shifts between past and present occasionally disorient more than they illuminate. The religious cult subplot, while thematically fitting, felt heavy-handed at times. Still, despite moments of frustration, I couldn't stop reading. Chanter's world feels both eerily plausible and dreamily strange and the emotional undercurrent, the ache of loss and the hunger for meaning lingers long after the final page.
