SHREDDED CHICKEN & WALNUT SALAD

FLAVOUR AND TEXTURE

Prep time: 20 mins - Cook time: 45 mins - Skill level: Low - Serves: 4

SUCCULENT SHREDDED CHICKEN, CRUNCHY APPLE, WALNUTS & FRESH VIBRANT BASIL. THIS SALAD IS PACKED WITH FLAVOUR & TEXTURE

Ingredients:

1 chicken breast fillet (220g), butterflied
1 lemon, zest and juice
1 clove garlic, minced
1 bay leaf
2 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
1/2 teaspoon salt flakes
1/4 teaspoon freshly cracked black pepper
1/2 head of cauliflower florets (reserve stalks)

Basil Pesto

45g pine nuts, toasted
1 cup of basil, washed and dried
2 small cloves garlic, halved
1 cup of olive oil
60g parmesan cheese, freshly grated
Salt flakes, to season
Freshly-cracked black pepper, to season

Ingredients for Salad:

A tangy apple, washed and thinly cut into matchsticks, sitting in acidulated water
12–15 mint leaves, torn

1/3 cup of toasted walnuts, coarsely chopped (could use whatever nut you have)

1 cup of any salad leaf, like lettuce or rocket, lightly torn.

1 celery heart stick, sliced on the diagonal (try and pick an inner pale rib from towards the centre so it's nice and sweet)

Reserved raw cauliflower stalk, pulsed to a rough rice.

Method:

1. Preheat oven to 200°C fan (220°C conventional).
2. Combine the chicken with lemon zest, juice, garlic, bay leaf, 1 tablespoon oil, salt and pepper and set aside to marinate.
3. Toss the cauliflower florets in the other tablespoon of oil and season with a pinch of salt. Set aside.
4. Once the oven has preheated, spread the cauliflower over a lined tray followed by the chicken, nuzzling the chicken amongst the florets. Bake for 12–15 minutes, or until the chicken juice comes out clear. Remove the chicken, to rest. If you'd like some more colour on your cauliflower, then pop back in the oven for another 10 minutes.
5. Meanwhile make the pesto by whizzing the toasted pine nuts, basil and garlic in a food processor. Slowly add olive oil until combined. Add parmesan and adjust seasoning.
6. Once the chicken is cooked and cool enough to handle, shred and place it in a large mixing bowl. Drain off the apples and add into the bowl along with mint leaves, walnuts, salad leaves, celery, roasted cauliflower, cauliflower rice and basil pesto. Toss and adjust seasoning with salt, pepper and olive oil as needed.
7. Serve the salad immediately and enjoy!

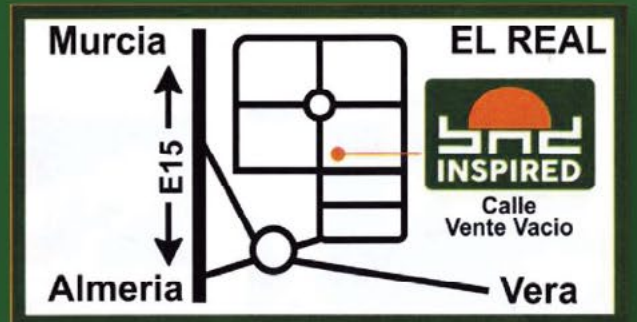

GIVEN THE OPTION, WOULD YOU WANT TO KNOW THE DATE OF YOUR OWN DEATH?

A recent book that I read, which I shall likely review in a future issue, inspired me to consider this question. Imagine, for a moment, that a mysterious figure appears before you. Not a terrifying Grim Reaper carrying a scythe, but perhaps a pleasant chap in a cardigan carrying a clipboard.

"Good afternoon," he says cheerfully. "I've popped by to let you know the exact date of your death. Would you like to know?"

What would you do?

Would you eagerly grab the information and demand details? Or would you run away faster than someone spotting their ex across a supermarket aisle?

It is a fascinating question and one that has appeared in books, films and philosophical discussions for years. If someone could tell you the exact date of your death, with 100% accuracy, would you choose to know?

At first glance, it seems like an easy answer. Most people immediately declare, "Absolutely not!" But the more you think about it, the more complicated it becomes.

Let's explore both sides of this peculiar dilemma.

The Case for Knowing

The strongest argument in favour of knowing your death date is simple: planning. Most of us spend our lives preparing for things. We save for retirement, buy insurance, schedule holidays and spend far too much time deciding what to have for dinner.

If you knew exactly when your life would end, you could plan with astonishing precision.

Imagine being told you will live until the age of 97. Suddenly, there is no rush. You can learn Italian at 70, take up salsa dancing at 80 and finally start writing that novel you've been talking about since 1998. You could stop worrying about every ache, pain and suspicious-looking mole. After all, if your date is fixed, then that headache

after three glasses of wine clearly isn't the end.

On the other hand, if you discovered you only had ten years left, your priorities might change dramatically. That dream trip around the world? Book it. The expensive bottle of wine you've been saving? Open it. The fancy towels you've been keeping for guests? Use them yourself. After all, what exactly are you waiting for? Knowing your date could encourage people to stop postponing happiness. Many of us live as though life comes with an unlimited extension package. We delay adventures, postpone dreams and save things for "someday". A definite deadline might motivate us to make the most of every moment.

The Financial Advantages

Let's be honest. There are practical benefits too.

If you knew you were going to live until 102, you might save more aggressively. If you knew you were departing at 75, you could stop worrying about running out of money at 95.

Financial advisers would probably love it. Retirement planning would become delightfully straightforward. "No need for complicated calculations, Mrs Smith. We can see you'll be leaving on 14 March 2087 at approximately tea time."

Morbid? Perhaps.

Efficient? Absolutely.

The Freedom Factor

There is also something oddly liberating about certainty. Many fears revolve around uncertainty rather than the event itself. People fear flying, illness, accidents and all manner of unlikely catastrophes.

But imagine knowing your death date is forty years away.

You could board aeroplanes with complete confidence.

Skydiving? Why not? Rollercoasters? Bring them on.

You would become virtually fearless.

The phrase "living life to the fullest" would take on a whole new meaning.

The Arguments Against Knowing Now let us consider the other side.

Suppose you are told that your death date is exactly twenty years from today. What happens tomorrow morning? Would you genuinely forget about it? Probably not.

The date would sit quietly in the back of your mind like an unwelcome house guest who refuses to leave.

Every birthday would feel different. Every New Year would become a countdown. Instead of celebrating milestones, you might find yourself calculating how many remain.

Twenty years becomes nineteen. Nineteen becomes eighteen. The countdown never stops.

Suddenly life resembles a particularly depressing advent calendar.

The Psychological Burden

Human beings are not always wonderful at handling information. We worry about things that may never happen. Imagine what we'd do with information guaranteed to happen.

If your date was relatively close, it could cast a shadow over everything. You might become obsessed with the approaching deadline. Every cold could feel significant. Every strange noise in the night might seem ominous.

Instead of freeing you from anxiety, the knowledge could create an entirely new kind of anxiety.

The uncertainty we currently live with might actually be healthier than absolute certainty.

The Risk of Giving Up

There is another danger. What if you knew you had many years left? Would you become careless? Would you stop looking after yourself? After all, if your death date is fixed, why bother eating salad? Why go to the gym? Why wear sunscreen?

You might spend the next twenty years eating doughnuts while announcing, "I'm perfectly safe until 2046!"

Of course, there are plenty of unpleasant things that

can happen before death. Nobody said anything about spending those years in peak condition.

Likewise, if your date was closer than expected, some people might simply lose motivation altogether. The knowledge could become a self-imposed prison.

The Great Spoiler Alert

Perhaps the biggest argument against knowing is that life thrives on surprise.

Imagine reading a detective novel where somebody tells you the ending on page one. The journey loses some of its magic.

Life works in much the same way.

Part of what makes existence extraordinary is not knowing what comes next. Unexpected friendships. Chance encounters. Last-minute adventures. Fortunate accidents. The wonderful unpredictability of it all.

Knowing the final chapter might change the way you experience every page that comes before it.

So Would I Want to Know?

After much consideration, I think my answer is no.

Tempting though it is, I suspect the knowledge would become impossible to ignore. I'd spend years trying not to think about it while secretly thinking about it all the time. I'd probably create elaborate spreadsheets, countdown clocks and colour-coded calendars.

I'd become unbearable at dinner parties.

"Only 6,842 days left," I'd announce while passing the potatoes. Nobody needs that kind of energy.

Instead, I rather like the mystery.

Not knowing forces us to appreciate today. It encourages us to tell people we love them, take opportunities when they appear and occasionally order dessert without overthinking it.

The uncertainty is frustrating, yes. But perhaps it is also what gives life its flavour.

After all, if there is one thing we know for certain, it is that none of us are getting out of this alive.

The date, however, remains hidden. Maybe that's exactly how it should be.

We are in a terrible mess. Our son who is 23 has got himself involved in drugs and we don't know what to do. He owes money everywhere, his girlfriend has gone and he's now in trouble with drug people he owes money to and wants us to pay them off. He was always a good lad up to this. We don't know where to turn.

Readers Answers

Unfortunately, usually when someone is addicted to drugs they always come up with a story that they owe money.

It's usually, more often than not, just to get money for more drugs. That is very typical and common, so be very careful that, if you decide to help, you are not actually fueling his need for more drugs.

The drug use won't stop until he gets the help he needs in a rehab. There maybe some good online support that might be worth looking into. Otherwise it is like throwing money into a bottomless pit and they will keep coming back for more.

That may not be the case with your son and how awful that you are going through this because you are between the devil and the deep blue sea. Paying off drug dealers is not the solution. He may say he is being threatened, do you actually have evidence of this? Please be careful, he needs professional help but it can only be when he wants it.

It's hard to see your loved ones hit rock bottom but sometimes that is the only way they can start to come back.

Hi Betty

I'm so sorry your lovely son has been taken over by addiction and he has been taken over, addiction has him now. This may seem harsh but you can only help him by not enabling his addiction further. This means not giving him any money and making sure he can't take it, or anything of value you own that he can sell. You can still offer him a home for now and food and love, but you cannot get involved with anything that continues to enable his habit. You can find out about local organisations where he can get help. They may also be able to help you. Give your son the information, then leave him to it, he has to decide to get help himself. I hope your son takes the help and support you offer him.

Your question doesn't say if he has stopped using drugs so, on that basis, I would ask him what he thinks the solution is and work through the reality of each element.

E.g. If he says that his parents should pay the debt, follow up questions could be:

How does he plan to pay them back?

How does he plan to pay for his ongoing drug use?

What does taking drugs give him or help him avoid?

Strong questions.

If he can't or won't answer at all I'd leave him to stew but give him the contact details of professionals who can help him come off the drugs.

If you can form a cohesive plan that works for everyone write it down. Sign it. Treat it like a contract and make it very clear that this is a one time offer.

FIRSTS

Here are some interesting 'firsts' from the world of sport, listed in no specific order.

* The first Summer Olympic Games took place in Athens in 1896 and in 1924 we saw the first winter Olympics take place in Chamonix, France.

* The NFL started in 1921 and it was the Chicago Stalleys who lifted the trophy. Their arch rivals the Chicago Bulldogs were the champions in 1922 and 1923.

* The Green Bay Packers won the first two USA Super bowl tournaments: 1967 and 1968.

* Football's World Cup started in 1930 and it was the hosts Uruguay who claimed the prize, beating Argentina 4-2 in Montevideo before a crowd of 68,346. Italy were champions in 1934, thus becoming the first European country to win the tournament.

* In 1956 Real Madrid became the first winners of the European Cup. In fact the Spanish giants won trophy again in 1957, 1958, 1959 and 1960 before Benfica ended their run.

* The 'English' Football League kicked off in season 1888-89. Twelve teams took part and it was Preston North End who came out winners... and they even retained the trophy the following season.

* A few years earlier, in season 1871-72, the FA Cup commenced and it was The Wanderers who ran out the winners - and they even retained the trophy the following season.

* The Scottish League got underway in season 1890-91 and it was Rangers and Dumbarton who celebrated - sharing the trophy after a controversial end of season play-off which ended in a 2-2 draw. Celtic came home in third place.

* Staying in Scotland - and Queen's Park were the first winners of the Scottish Cup in 1874 and Rangers won the initial League Cup competition in 1947.

* In athletics... and the American sprinter Carl Lewis was the first runner to retain the men's 100 metres title, doing so in 1984 and 1988.

* Lassi Viren of Finland was the first athlete to win back-to-back 5,000 metres and 10,000 metres gold medals at the Olympic games of 1972 and 1976.

* The USA relay teams won the first two gold medals in the 1908 and 1912 four x 400 metres events.

* The first 13 American marathons were all won by a runner from the States: 1970-82 inclusive.

* The first dead heat in the London marathon was recorded in 1981 when the American Dick Beardsley and the Dane Jacob Simonsen crossed the line together.

* A British competitor won each of the first 19 All England Badminton championships.

* The Boston Red Sox had the honour of winning the first World Series baseball title in 1903.

* The first undisputed World Heavyweight boxing champion was the American James J. Corbett who took the title in 1892. Bob Fitzsimons was the first Brit to win the title in 1897 and the first boxer to win the British title was Charlie Mitchell in 1894.

* Cricket's World Cup competition was first held in 1975 and it was won by the West Indies, with Viv Richards, Clive Lloyd, Alvin Kallicharran, Rohan Kanhai, Andy Roberts, wicket-keeper Deryck Murray and Roy Fredericks the star players.

* Surrey won the very first County Cricket Championship, claiming the prize in 1864.

* The first cricketer to average over 100 runs per innings of a season worldwide was the great Australian Don Bradman with figures of 115.66 in 1938. The first Englishman to average over a century was Yorkshire opening Geoff Boycott with 100.12 in 1971. Eight years later Boycott averaged 102.53.

* The first bowler to return a seasonal average of under 10 per wicket was Englishman Dick Pougher of Leicestershire in 1894.

* Derbyshire's Wilfred 'Dusty' Rhodes was the top bowler in County cricket seven times - in 1900, 1901, 1919, 1920, 1922, 1923 and 1926. No-one has ever got near to matching this record.

* The first England v. Australia Test Match took place in March 1877 at the MCG (Melbourne Cricket Ground) and it was the hosts who won the game by 45 runs. England's Alf Shaw bowled the first ball in this game and Aussie opener Charlie Bannerman scored the first Test run. He later had the pleasure of scoring the first 'Test' century.

* The first Tour of France cycle race took place in 1903 and it was home rider Maurice Garin who was first over the finishing line.

* In the world of darts, Welshman Leighton Rees was the game's first winner of the World professional Championship, doing so in 1978.

* Limerick were the first winners of the All-Ireland Gaelic football championship in 1887. The first team to win the prize twice was Dublin, in 1891 and 1892.

* The British Open Golf Championship took place in 1860 at Prestwick in Scotland and it was the bearded Willie Park senior who was the first winner of the coveted trophy.

* The first winner of the USA Open golf title was Jim Barnes in 1916 at the Siwanoy Country club in New York and the USA had the honour of being the first recipients of the Ryder Cup, beating Team GB in 1927.

Mojácar 2026

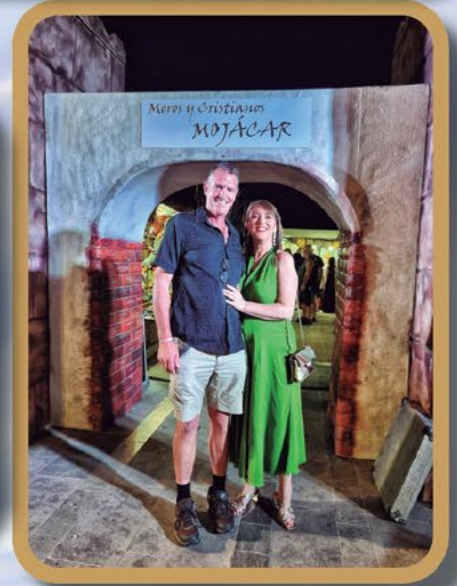


Mojácar once again pulled out all the stops for its spectacular Moors and Christians Festival, held from 11th to 14th June.

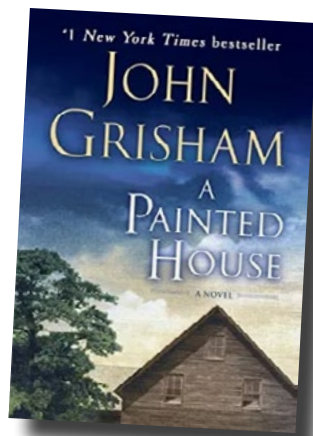

BOOK REVIEW

A PAINTED HOUSE

by John Grisham

A Painted House by John Grisham is a luminous departure from the courtroom dramas and legal thrillers that have long defined his formidable reputation. For readers accustomed to high stakes litigation and brisk procedural intrigue, this novel arrives as a revelation. It is quieter, more contemplative, and profoundly intimate. In relinquishing the legal arena, Grisham reveals an altogether different register of storytelling, one steeped in memory, landscape, and the fragile intensity of childhood perception. Set in rural Arkansas during the 1950s, the novel is narrated through the observant eyes of young Luke Chandler, a boy growing up on a cotton farm. The rhythms of agrarian life are rendered with painstaking detail. Fields stretch endlessly beneath a merciless sun. The labour of picking cotton becomes both backdrop and crucible for human drama. Grisham evokes this world with an authenticity that feels lived rather than researched, suggesting deep personal familiarity with its textures and cadences.



There is, throughout the novel, a distinct atmosphere reminiscent of Little House on the Prairie. The simplicity of rural existence, the centrality of family bonds, and the quiet endurance required by hardship all echo that earlier literary tradition. Yet Grisham tempers pastoral nostalgia with moral complexity. Beneath the surface of community life lie tensions of class, race, and secrecy. Violence and betrayal intrude upon innocence, shattering any illusion that this is merely a sentimental portrait of country living. What makes A Painted House so compelling is its emotional subtlety. Luke's voice is suffused with curiosity and dawning awareness. He witnesses events that exceed his comprehension, and the reader feels the poignant gap between childhood understanding and adult reality. Grisham handles these moments with restraint, allowing implication to carry more weight than exposition. The result is a narrative that resonates long after its final pages.

Stylistically, the prose is elegant in its simplicity. Grisham resists ornamentation, favouring clarity and measured pacing. This restraint lends the novel a quiet dignity. The landscape itself becomes a character, shaping destinies as decisively as any human choice.

In A Painted House, John Grisham proves that his literary prowess extends far beyond the courtroom. He crafts a tender, evocative, and deeply humane story that stands apart within his oeuvre. It is a novel of memory and maturation, imbued with warmth and shadow in equal measure.
